Office of the President has provided revisions the University Whistleblowers policy and to APM Section 190, Appendix A-2. for Systemwide review. Systemwide Review is a public review by the general University community, affected employees and unions. Systemwide Review also includes a mandatory, three-month full Senate review. The proposal implements policy requirements mandated by an amendment to the California Whistleblower Protection Act that became effective January 1, 2011. The UC Whistleblower Protection Policy is a systemwide, Presidential Policy that applies to all University employees, which includes all faculty and other academic appointees, students, and staff.
