The Office of the President recently circulated proposed revisions to the Academic Personnel Manual (APM) sections describing the Lecturer with Security of Employment (SOE) Series for comment by the broader campus community.

The proposed revisions are intended to make the title more accurately reflect the requirements for advancement in the series and to make hiring, evaluation, and promotion practices more consistent across the UC system. Key revisions include: (1) a recommended title change to "Teaching Professor", (2) enhanced descriptions and criteria for teaching excellence and professional and scholarly achievement and activity, and (3) the application of sabbatical leave policies.

I invite you to join me at a session for appointees in the SOE series and Department Chairs from units that employee SOE appointees to discuss the proposed changes. This session will give attendees the opportunity to provide feedback that will inform the campus response to the proposed changes, and to discuss what the changes might mean for appointees in the series.
