Definition: Regularly scheduled instructional offering requiring significant academic preparation outside class and meeting a minimum of three hours per week.	1.00
B. Course Equivalencies (Values are expressed in terms proportionate to an IWC)	
C. Other Equivalencies	
1. Additional section of an IWC offering	.50
2. Two-hour lecture requiring significant preparation outside class	.67
3. Team-teaching a course (i.e. two lecturers equally sharing the teaching of one IWC offering)	.67
4. Voluntary non-standard courses (e.g. directed research, projects, industry internships, independent studies)	.00
5. Supervision of TAs for courses with 4-6 discussion sections (regularly scheduled meetings at least one hour per week)	.25
6. TA supervision for more than 6 discussion sections	.05/ section
