<i>Definition:</i> Regularly scheduled instructional offering requiring significant academic preparation outside class and meeting a minimum of three hours per week.	
B. Course Equivalencies (values are expressed in terms proportional to an IWC)	
1. IWC offerings with a student cap of at least 200	1.50
2. IWC offerings with a student cap of at least 286	2.00
C. Other Equivalencies	
1. Team-teaching a course (i.e., two lecturers equally sharing the teaching of one IWC offering)	0.75
