Definition: Regularly scheduled instructional offering requiring significant academic preparation outside class and meeting a minimum of three hours per week.	1.00
B. Course Equivalencies (Values are expressed in terms proportionate to an IWC)	
1. Any IWC course with an enrollment over 100 and no Teaching Assistant assigned.	1.33
2. Any IWC course with an enrollment over 140; the course is sectioned and Teaching Assistants are assigned.	1.25
3. Any IWC course with assigned labs.	1.25
4. Any IWC course with assigned field trips.	1.25
5. L&S 192	.50
6. PS 594 (With prior approval from Letters and Science only)	.25 per unit 1.00/qtr.
C. Other Equivalencies	
1. Additional section of an IWC offering	.50
2. Two-hour lecture requiring significant preparation outside class	.67
3. Team-teaching a course (i.e., two lecturers equally sharing the teaching of one IWC offering)	.67
4. Voluntary non-standard courses (e.g., directed research, projects, industry internships, independent studies)	.00
