A. Instructional Workload Course (IWC)	1.00
<i>Definition: Regularly scheduled instructional offering requiring significant academic preparation outside class and meeting a minimum of three hours per week.⁸</i>	
B. Course Equivalencies (Values are expressed in terms proportionate to an IWC)	
1. Soc 152 (enrollment over 200 and team-taught) ¹	1.00
2. Soc 194 (subject to minimum enrollment of 3 students)	.25/unit to 1.00 max/yr
3. Courses with enrollments over 200 (not team taught)	1.33
4. Soc 195H	.25/qtr to .75 max/yr
C. Other Equivalencies	
1. Additional section of an IWC offering	0.50
2. Two-hour lecture requiring significant preparation	0.67
3. Team-teaching a course (i.e., two lecturers equally sharing the teaching of one IWC offering)	0.67
4. Voluntary non-standard courses (e.g., directed research, projects, industry internships, independent studies)	0.00
5. Supervision of TAs for courses with 4-5 discussion sections (regularly scheduled meetings at least 1 hour per week)	0.25
6. TA supervision for more than 6 TAs per memo 2/27/87.	0.05 per TA
7. Curriculum Development ² (at least 5 hours per week per quarter)	0.33 to 1.00 max/yr
8. Leading a 50 min discussion section which meets weekly	0.33 to 1.00 max/qtr
