Hiring Transactions for Postdoc Paid Direct and Fellow Positions

A new job aid providing detailed guidance on the proper set up of Postdoc positions is available in the UCPath UPK's - <u>Job Aid: Postdoc Job Setup for Multiple Concurrent Jobs (Postdoc plus non-Postdoc Job).</u> The following guidance is to supplement this job aid, providing detail on entering the proper data points into Hire transactions.

Single Job Postdoc Hire:

Postdocs hired into one position should use the following data points in the **Job Compensation – Pay Components** section of the **Hire** transaction:

Job Code/Title	Comp Rate Code	Compensation Rate	Compensation Frequency
003252 – Postdoc-Employee	UCANNL	Annual Rate (e.g. \$65,000)	A (Annual)
003253 – Postdoc-Fellow	UCFELL	Annual Rate (e.g. \$65,000)	A (Annual)
003254 – Postdoc-Paid Direct	UCPDPD	Annual Rate (e.g. \$65,000)	A (Annual)

Single Job Postdoc Paid Direct Example:



^{*}Note: the Comp Rate Code and Compensation Rate fields are entered by the transaction initiator. The Compensation Frequency field is auto-derived based on the Comp Rate Code used, and should not be overwritten by the transactor.

Multiple Jobs Postdoc Fellow or Paid Direct AND Postdoc Employee:

The Postdoc Employee set up within the Hire transaction matches the <u>Single Job Postdoc Hire</u> using the **Comp Rate Code** of **UCANNL** and **Compensation Rate** at the annual rate (e.g. \$60,000), as shown above. The Fellow or Paid Direct set up within the Hire transaction differs to reflect monthly codes and rates, as follows:

Job Code/Title	Comp Rate Code	Compensation Rate	Compensation Frequency
003253 – Postdoc-Fellow	UCFELM	Monthly Rate (e.g. \$4,000)	M (Monthly)
003254 – Postdoc-Paid Direct	UCPDMO	Monthly Rate (e.g. \$4,000)	M (Monthly)

Multiple Jobs Postdoc Fellow Example:



*Note: the Comp Rate Code and Compensation Rate fields are input by the transaction initiator.

- The Compensation Frequency field is auto-derived based on the Comp Rate Code used
- the Job Compensation—Payroll Currency & Frequency is auto-derived based on the Job Code

Both of the **Frequency** fields in the **Hire** transaction <u>should not</u> be overwritten by the transactor.
